

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR COURT AND COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

Requirements for graduation and specified alternative means for completing the prescribed course of study shall be made available to students, parents/guardians, and the public. [Education Code (E.C.) 51225.3] (BP 6146.1)

Students shall not be required to have resided within the district for any minimum length of time as a condition of high school graduation. [E.C. 51411]

If a student successfully completes the district's graduation requirements while attending a juvenile court school or nonpublic, nonsectarian school or agency, the district shall issue the student a diploma from the school the student last attended. [E.C. 48645.5]

If a student successfully completes the Monterey County Office of Education's (MCOE) requirements for graduation but has not completed the requirements from his/her last district, the student will be issued an MCOE diploma.
