Resolution Adopting A Conflict of Interest Code

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code (GC) 87300-87313, requires each public agency in California to adopt a conflict of interest code; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) has previously adopted a local conflict of interest code as expressed in BP 4010; and

WHEREAS, past and future amendments to the Political Reform Act and implementing regulations may require conforming amendments to be made to the County Superintendent’s conflict of interest code as expressed in BP 4010; and

WHEREAS, a regulation adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, 2 California Code of Regulations (CCR) 18730, provides that incorporation by reference of the terms of that regulation, along with an agency-specific appendix designating positions and disclosure categories shall constitute the adoption and amendment of a conflict of interest code in conformance with GC 87300 and 87306; and

WHEREAS, the County Superintendent has recently reviewed its positions, and the duties of each position, and has determined that changes to the current conflict of interest code are necessary; and

WHEREAS, any earlier resolutions, versions of BP 4010 (before _____), and/or appendices containing the County Superintendent's conflict of interest code are rescinded and superseded by this resolution; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Monterey County Superintendent adopts the Conflict of Interest Code including its Appendix of Designated Positions and Disclosure Categories as shown in BP 4010.
