

TERMS OF OFFICE

The Monterey County Board of Education shall consist of seven members whose terms shall be staggered so that as nearly as practicable, one half of the members shall be elected in each even-numbered year. The term of office for members elected in regular elections shall be four years.

Members elected the first Tuesday in November shall take the oath of office on the second Friday in December following their election. [Education Code (EC) 1007]

A member whose term has expired shall continue to discharge the duties of the office until a successor has qualified by taking the oath of office. [Government Code 1302, 1360; EC 5017]
