

RESIGNATION

Monterey County Board of Education (County Board) members who wish to resign shall file a written resignation with the Monterey County Superintendent of Schools. County Board members shall also give a copy of the written resignation to the County Board President. [Education Code (EC) 1008, 5090]

The resignation shall become effective when filed, except when a deferred effective date is specified in the resignation. A board member may not defer the effective date of his/her resignation for more than sixty (60) days after filing. A written resignation, whether specifying a deferred effective date or otherwise, shall be irrevocable once filed. [EC 5090, 5091]

A board member who tenders his/her resignation with a deferred effective date shall, until the effective date of the resignation, continue to exercise all the powers of the office, except those involving the provisional appointment of his/her successor. [EC 5091, 35178]

A County Board member who resigns shall file, within 30 days of leaving office, a revised Statement of Economic Interest/Form 700 covering the period of time between the closing date of the last statement required to be filed and the date he/she leaves office. [Government Code 87302, 87500]
