

COUNTY BOARD MEMBER ABSENCES

No member of the Monterey County Board of Education (County Board) shall be absent from the state of California for more than 45 days, unless either:

1. Upon business of the County Board; or
2. With the consent of the County Board.

In the case of illness or other urgent necessity and upon a proper showing thereof, the time limited for absence from the state may be extended by the County Board for an additional period not to exceed 90 days.

If a County Board member ceases to discharge his/her duties of office for a period of three (3) consecutive months, except when prevented by illness or injury, or when absent from the state with County Board permission, his/her office becomes vacant.

When a Board member knows he/she will be unable to attend a scheduled meeting, he/she should notify the Monterey County Superintendent of Schools' office as soon as possible.
