

TECHNOLOGY PLAN

The County Board of Education recognizes that technology can greatly enhance the instructional program as well as the efficiency of district and school site administration. The Board also realizes that careful planning is essential to ensure the successful, equitable and cost-effective implementation of technology-based materials, equipment, systems and networks.

The Superintendent shall develop a plan to address the short- and long-term technology needs of the County Office of Education and provide for compatibility of resources among school sites, and other County Office operations.
