

CONCEPTS AND ROLES

The Monterey County Board of Education (County Board) recognizes the business and non-instructional operations as functions that are essential to accomplishing the goals of the Monterey County Office of Education (MCOE). Business and non-instructional operations support the facilities, property, grounds, schools, and programs operated by the Monterey County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) and provide mandated services to meet the legal responsibilities of the County Board, County Superintendent, and school and community college districts.

The County Board believes that adequate funding and careful money management provide foundational support for MCOE. It is the intent of the County Board to make that support as effective as possible. The County Superintendent should inform the County Board about financial operations of MCOE to enable the County Board to fully discharge its legal responsibilities.
