

**CLAIMS AND ACTIONS AGAINST THE MONTEREY
COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND/OR THE
COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS**

Any and all claims for money or damages against the Board of Education and/or the Monterey County Superintendent of Schools, their agents, or employees, must be presented to and acted upon in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Compliance with Monterey County Office of Education regulations and procedures is a prerequisite to any court action, unless the claim is governed by statutes or regulations which expressly free the claimant from the obligation to comply with this policy and the claims procedures set forth in Government Code Section 900 et seq.

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to take action on claims up to the amount of the deductible identified in the insurance policy.

The Superintendent shall develop regulations to implement this policy and appropriate Government Code Sections. (Government Code 935.4)
