

FACILITIES INSPECTION

The Monterey County Board of Education (County Board) recognizes that the condition of Monterey County Office of Education (MCOE) facilities may have an impact on student achievement and employee morale, and desires to provide facilities that are safe, clean, and functional, as defined in Education Code 17002.

The Monterey County Superintendent of Schools or designee should develop a facilities inspection and maintenance program, including deferred maintenance, to ensure that MCOE facilities are maintained in good repair in accordance with law.

The Superintendent is expected to provide the County Board with regular reports regarding the status of facilities.
