2. Purpose of the MCOE CALPADS Committee
  - *Mary White explained that we will be working together to create systems that support efficient CALPADS data management, both for periodic Collection Window submissions and for ongoing updating.*
  - *Julie High distributed the most recent information update by Cindy Kazanis, Director, Educational Data Management Division, CDE, presented to the Regional Assessment Network, January 22, 2014. The main point of this presentation is to emphasize that the role of CALPADS has changed because, "CALPADS data are being used more frequently for high stakes purposes." The new TIDE (Test Information Distribution Engine) data system that will register students for Smarter Balanced Assessments will draw its data from CALPADS and deliver updated information for student testing within 48 hours of updates to CALPADS.*

*Will CALPADS allow the upload of more than one file in one day without having to wait for the nightly refresh of data to upload additional data?*
