Jennifer Abrams – Being Generationally Savvy & Having Hard Conversations (Oct. 16th & Feb. 20th): Jennifer Abrams provides trainings, coaching, program design and consultative support to schools, hospitals and other organizations in the areas of instructional design, new employee support, supervision and evaluation, having hard conversations, generational savvy and the creation of collaborative cultures. Jennifer considers herself to be a "voice coach," helping others develop their identities and skill sets to best use their voices in a variety of professional environments. Ernie Mendez – Empty the Cup & Engage for Learning (Oct. 26th & 27th): Dr. Ernie Mendes is an author, executive coach, and a professional development trainer. He has been training Teachers and Leaders since 1988 and has worked with over 50 diverse organizations, including businesses, school districts, law enforcement agencies, and health centers. Dr. Mendes' diverse professional background includes a combined 23 years as a classroom teacher at the secondary and post-secondary level and 11 years as a licensed psychotherapist in private practice. He holds a Ph.D. in Psychology. His trainings consistently receive high reviews. His book *Empty the Cup . . . Before You Fill It Up* is a best seller with practical activities to build effective relationships at work and in the classroom using E.I. theory and

neuroscience. His recent book *Engage 4 Learning* uses four main brain systems to engage K-Adult learners in educational settings.

Lou Denti – Proactive Classroom Management: Dr. Denti is a former special educator and administrator, and is currently the Lawton Love Distinguished Professor of Special Education and Director of the Center for Reading Diagnosis and Instruction at **California State University, Monterey Bay**. His research focuses on student behavior, special education, inclusion, and literacy. Dr. Denti has dedicated his life to helping those who struggle to learn. Educators across the country have benefited from his research, publications and presentations. In 2009 he delivered the keynote address at the annual meeting of the Ohio School Speech Pathology and Educational Audiology Consortium and received the organization's Annie Glenn National Leadership Award. The award is named for Annie Glenn, wife of former astronaut and Senator John Glenn, and an adjunct professor in the Department of Speech and Hearing Science at Ohio State University.
