

Categorical Program Monitoring (CPM) Cycle

In 2006-07 we equalized the annual CPM workload within each of the 11 California county service regions. The table at the bottom of this page lists the LEAs according to region and cycle.

Purpose

The purpose of regional equalization is to provide greater consistency in staffing monitoring teams and equalization of work across the years. The CPM four-year cycle aligns and distributes the annual CPM workload for the California Department of Education (CDE) within each of the 11 California county service regions.

Background

The use of the county regional structure aligns monitoring with other CDE, regional, district, and school improvement activities (e.g., Regional System for District and School Support). Local educational agencies (LEAs) are placed in monitoring Cycle A (for _____), Cycle B (for _____), Cycle C (for _____), or Cycle D (_____). Due to its size, Los Angeles Unified School District is monitored annually. Equalization with each region was achieved by analyzing the potential number of CPM visits, potential sites to visit, and the potential days for conducting visits. Consideration was given for other regional CPM work, including trainings, response to inquiries, and follow-up to visits.
