The SAT[®]: Design, Support, and Opportunities for Students

The PSAT 8/9, new PSAT/NMSQT[®] and new SAT[®] launched in 2015-16. With the assessments came new scholarship and practice opportunities for students as they begin to take ownership of their college going preparations.

Administration of the PSAT/NMSQT provides a direct correlation to student performance on AP exams and also serves as an indicator for school site leaders on how to ensure AP course offerings align to students' demonstrated performance.

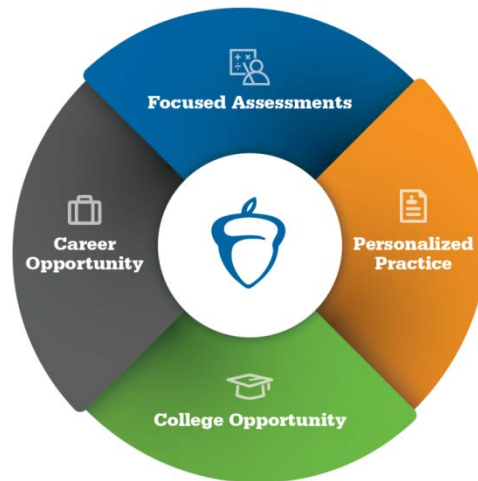
