## **REMOVING BARRIERS TO EDUCATION FOR HOMELESS AND FOSTER STUDENTS**

In 2014, the state and federal government passed significant legislative changes that impact our homeless and foster students. The Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) mandates that school districts provide additional services and support to homeless and foster students, in addition to English Learners. To assure that districts and communities are **aware of and compliant with these new laws**, the Monterey County Office of Education is hosting training for schools and communities to learn about this legislation and the implications it has for serving our homeless and foster students.

This **free** workshop will provide:

- Information regarding new regulations and compliance with the McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act
- Training for registrars, secretaries and front office staff regarding enrollment and treatment of foster and homeless students
- AB490 and other legislative updates
- Testimonials from foster and homeless youth.

Who should attend?

- School secretaries, school community liaisons, registrars, front office staff, homeless and foster student liaisons, community-based organizations that service foster and homeless youth, and social services agencies.
