  - Tutoring/after school help
  
- ✓ What would make school/learning more interesting and fun for you and your classmates?
  - Games, experiments, projects
  - Technology
  - Three-way tie:
    - Field trips
    - ROP/Military options
    - Discussions/presentations
  
- ✓ What can your school do to help you attend more regularly?
  - I already attend school regularly
  - Make it more interesting/fun
  - Later start time, breakfast
  - Transportation assistance
  
- ✓ What do you need to feel safe at school?
  - I already feel safe
  - More staff
  - Three-way tie:
    - Counselor
    - Security/Probation
    - Friends

- ✓ How do you know when adults in your school care about you? Believes in you?
  - They ask questions/get to know you/spend time with you
  - Willing to help you/they do things to help you
  - They encourage you
  - They tell you/show you
  
- ✓ What do you need from adults in your school to help you achieve your goals?
  - General help (goals, academics)
  - Five-way tie:
    - Resources
    - Good learning environment
    - Time/patience
    - Support & show they care/encouragement
    - Teach better, have helpers
