1. How often and in which ways are stakeholders being engaged and updated on the district's progress toward the locally identified metrics and expenditures? What does it look like? How does it compare to last year?
2. In what manner is the Board of Trustees kept abreast of the district's implementation of services/actions, expenditures, and progress on locally identified metrics? How frequently? What is shared? Who is sharing? How is it shared?
3. By what method is the district tracking supplemental/concentration funding expenditures?
4. How is the district tracking MPP expenditures to ensure this is met?
5. How does your district distinguish the cost of core/base programs from additional services?
6. How is the district tracking the progress of target student groups against the locally identified metrics?
7. How have your assessment results, thus far, measured the steps towards achieving your goals?
