## Transitional Kindergarten Attendance Reporting

As school districts report on Transitional Kindergarten (TK), the California Department of Education (CDE) has added a new informational TK line to various reports in the Principal Apportionment Revenue and Attendance Data Collection Software. The software allows districts to report, pursuant to Education Code Section 46300, the amount of kindergarten average daily attendance that is attributable to TK. For funding purposes, TK and kindergarten funding are both still entered on the kindergarten line in the state attendance software.

The CDE has created a reference table in its Version Release Notes, which can be found [here](#), that tells local educational agencies which specific line number to provide the attendance information on, based upon which type of agency reporting. For those districts that did not have the opportunity to enter this attendance information into the new informational attendance lines at First Principal Apportionment, it can be entered into the system at Second Principal Apportionment. With this attendance reporting information, districts and the state will hopefully have a sense of how many students participated in TK in the 2012-13 school year.
