## Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Closure of Millennium Charter High School

**Q: Why is the school closing?**

A: The Monterey County Board of Education voted to revoke the school’s charter at their June 5, 2019 Board of Education Meeting.

**Q: When is the school closing?**

A: The school will be closed as of June 30, 2019. To confirm the dates and times staff will be holding office hours, the Superintendent/Principal of Millennium Charter High School has requested all questions be directed to her email at [mburns@mchs.school](mailto:mburns@mchs.school).

**Q: How will I find a new school? When does school start after the summer break?**

A: Families have a variety of options for the 2019-20 school year. They include:

- Students can enroll in alternative programs provided by their district of residency. Contact district of residency for more information.
- Students can enroll in MCOE alternative programs, including iTAP (Innovation Technology Arts Pathway) and SAFE (Sea Air Faire Earth, a STEAM Pathway). Contact the MCOE Alternative Education Department at 831-784-4224 for more information.
- Students can enroll in the Monterey County Home Charter program. Contact Home Charter at 831-755-0331 for more information.
- Students can enroll in private or online high school programs offered throughout Monterey County.

You can help by contacting the school/district/program as soon as possible so you, or your student, can register to start the 2019-20 school year.

**Q: How do I obtain a copy of my student's records?**

A: Parents can request student records from Millennium Charter High School.

**Q: Do I have to give my student's records to his/her new school?**

A: When a student enrolls in a new school, the receiving school will request records from the previous school.

- You can help by requesting your child's immunization records from Millennium if you do not have a copy.
- You can help by taking a copy of your child's IEP to the new school when you enroll if your child receives special education services. If you do not have the IEP, let the school know your child received services from a Resource Specialist or a Speech and Language Therapist. The new school will request the IEP along with other school records.
- You can help by gathering two documents that show where you live like a lease agreement and utility bill. If you do not have this information, you cannot be denied enrollment, but you may need to take additional steps to enroll yourself/your child.
- After July 1, 2019, you can help by providing the school with this MCOE telephone number to use if they need assistance getting records: (831) 755-6463.

**Q: What will happen to student records after the school closes?**

A: The law requires Millennium to transfer all student records to MCOE upon closure. Any student records that have not been forwarded to a student's new school will be stored at MCOE. Schools may request records from MCOE.
