## Federal Program Monitoring

Our county office and several of our sub-grant districts are up for federal program monitoring. The process involves the collection of evidence and submission of all of the compliance items for our program. Migrant Education has 7 dimensions ranging from Parent engagement to fiscal compliance. Dr. Vela will be attending a two-day FPM training in Sacramento to learn more. Furthermore, the region will convene a team of stakeholders to be part of the evidence collection and possible interview with FPM officials. The FPM process is an opportunity to demonstrate our fidelity to our program and to showcase the great systems we have in place.



## Improved MSIN 6.0

MSIN 6.0 users will find several new features. Some that Region 16 can take credit for, like the feature to document contacts with families and the feature to report services to a group. We encourage all staff with MSIN 6.0 access to log on and explore the updated site. We will provide an in-service to all staff in September at the first I&R/Health Collaboration Meeting. The new MSIN 6.0 Features will improve our documentation of services and our ability to enroll and withdraw students more effectively. Thank you to Efrain Magallanes for leading the way with this improved tool.



## Arizona Visit

In efforts to increase our collaboration and coordination of services to our families, a contingency from Arizona will visit Region 16 on August 22-24, 2017. The visit will involve our Identification and Recruitment staff as well as our program staff to exchange best practices and solidify our programs for the hundreds of families that we share. We are the first in California to broker such a meeting and again setting the example of leadership and effectiveness. We will provide staff with more details within the next weeks. We are attempting to seek approval for a contingency from our region to visit Arizona in the near future. Stay tuned.
