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This workshop provides a walkthrough of the website created by the California Autism Professional Training and Information Network (CAPTAIN). Links at this website provide information about evidence-based practices for implementation with students and adults on the autism spectrum. The National Professional Development Center on Autism Spectrum Disorders website and the National Autism Center website are explored. At these sites the Autism Focused Intervention Resources and Modules (AFIRM) and the Autism Internet Modules are examined. In addition, other resources including the Center for Disease Control (CDC) fact sheets on Autism Spectrum Disorders, California Department of Education's (CDE) Early Childhood Transitions Guide, and the Autism Distance Education Parent Training Modules from the UC Davis Mind Institute are examined.
